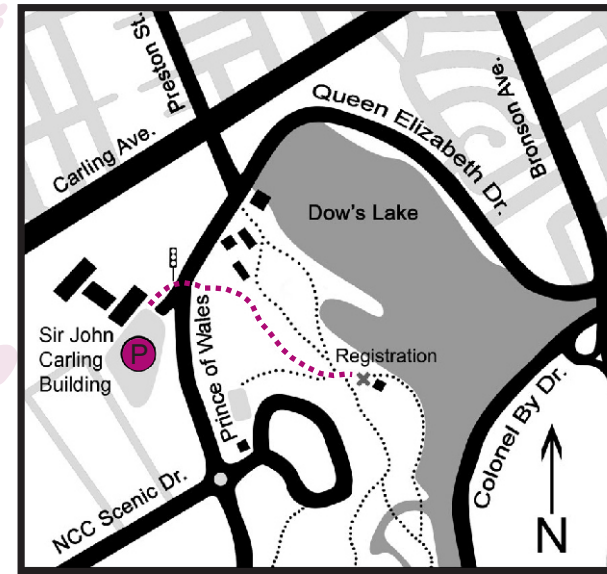
When & Where

- Stoop and Scoop bylaw in effect.



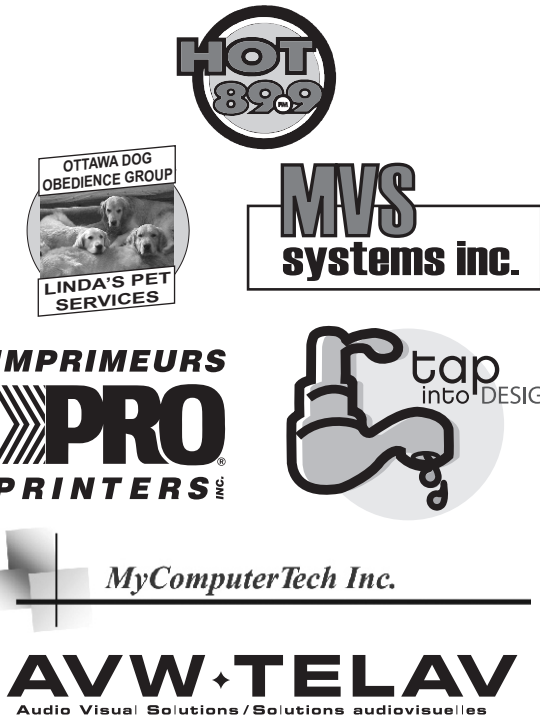
Please note that this year's walk is in a different area of the Arboretum than in previous years.
